This property is located at Atolia, California, and in the Rand Mining District, is the Northwest corner of San Bernardino County, and is only one-fourth mile from the station of Atolia, on the Atchison, Topeka & Sante Fe Railway. This property adjoins on the east the property of the Atolia Mining and Milling Company. This property consists of a group of (7) full claims and 1 fraction and is on unpatented claims. 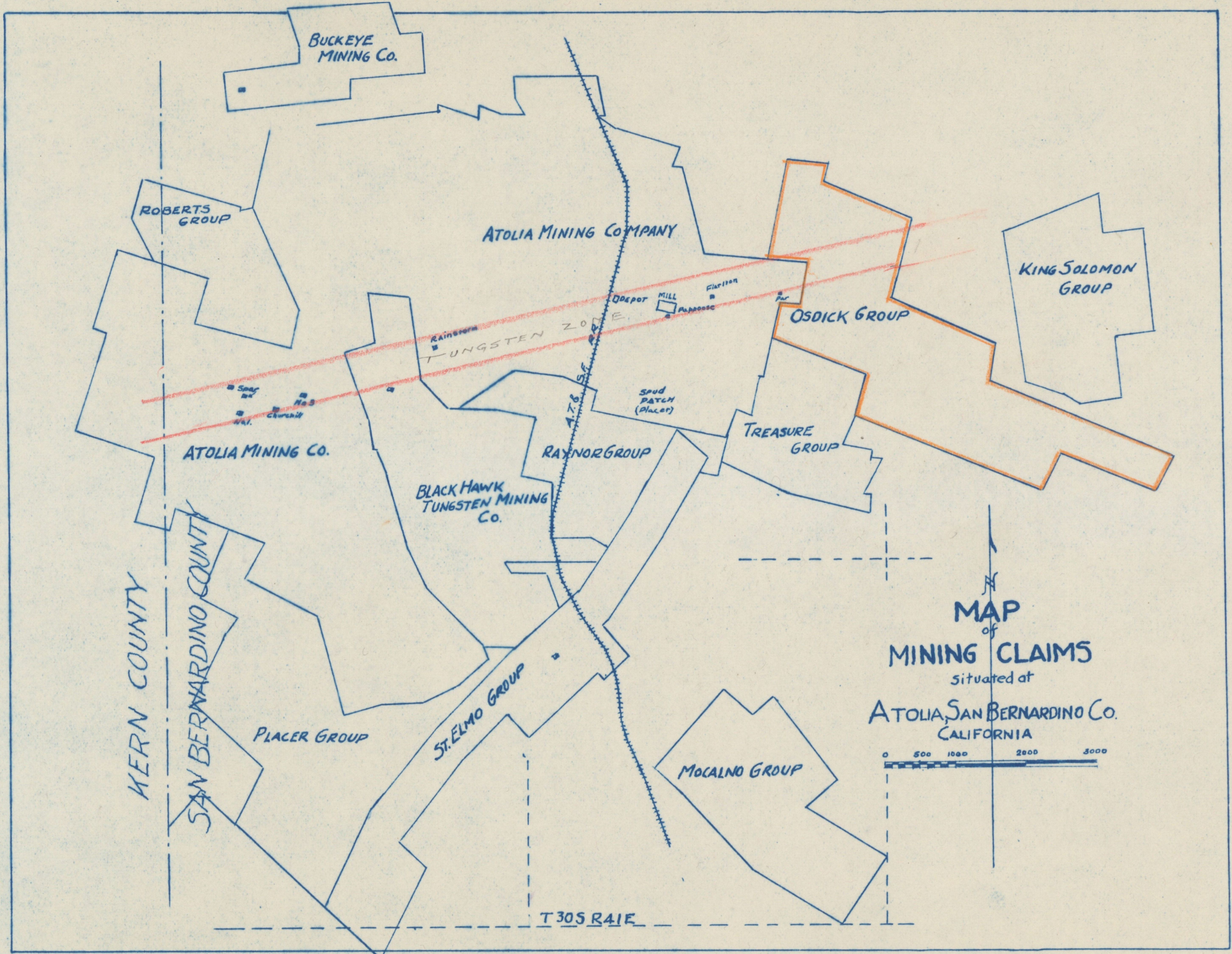
Mr. H. J. Morgan,
