For value received we, PHILIP R. STANHOPE and FREDERICK S. STEPHENSON hereby assign, transfer and set over unto The S. & S. Mining Company, all our right, title, interest, claim and demand in and to the following described contracts, to wit:-

(1) A certain contract dated August 19th, 1899, and various modifications thereof, between Philip R. Stanhope and John H. Kemp, relating to the purchase by said Kemp of the so called Blue Ridge property, mentioned and described in a proposition signed this day by us and directed to said company.

(2) A certain contract dated September 27-1901, between St D. Gynlais Walters and Philip R. Stanhope and Samuel A. Barbour relating to the purchase by said Stanhope and Barbour of an undivided one half (1/2) interest in the so called Silent Friend group of mines; also described in said proposition.

(3) A certain contract dated about April 20th, 1901, between Jay Morton and Philip R. Stanhope, relating to the purchase by Stanhope of the Comstock lode U. S. Survey No. 198, and other mining premises on Red Elephant Mountain, in the Downieville Mining District, Clear Creek County, Colorado.

(4) A certain contract dated November 1st, 1901, between Samuel A. Barbour and Philip R. Stanhope, relating to the purchase by said Stanhope of certain interests of said Barbour in and to the said Silent Friend Group of Mines, and other mining premises in the counties of Clear Creek and Gilpin in the State of Colorado.

(5) Two certain contracts, dated December 5, 1901, between Philip R. Stanhope, Frederick S. Stephen and The Syndicate Gold Mining Company, of the one part, and George H. Campbell of the other part, relating to the purchase by said Campbell of certain interests in the so called Blue Ridge property, aforementioned, and other property in the County of Clear Creek, State of Colorado.

(6) A certain prospectors' contract, and all rights thereunder, between H. H. Stebbins and said Stanhope and Stephen, whereby said Stebbins is prosecuting certain prospecting in the Territory of Arizona for the joint benefit of all of the parties to said agreement.
