

THIS AGREEMENT made this 20th day of June, A. D. 1893
by and between Otto A. G. Rausch, party of the first part,
and Phillip R. Stanhope and W. L. Ireland, parties of the
second part, WITNESSETH;

That the party of the first part in consideration
of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the parties
of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged, hereby promises and agrees with the parties of the
second part, to sell, assign and transfer unto the parties
of the second part five thousand shares of the Capital Stock
of The Capital Mountain, Tunnel & Milling Company, of Col-
orado, free and clear from all liens, claims or incumbrances
of any kind or nature whatsoever, upon the payment by the
parties of the second part to the party of the first part,
as purchase price for said stock, the sum of Fifteen Thou-
sand Dollars, together with interest at the rate of six per
cent per annum from the 10th day of March, A. D. 1892,
before the 20th day of December A. D. 1893, which said sum
and interest said parties of the second part hereby agree
to pay to the said party of the first part, as purchase price
for said stock on or before the date last aforesaid, free
and clear from all liens, claims or incumbrances or any
kind or nature whatsoever; and the said party of the first
part has this day deposited with The Denver National Bank of
Denver, certificates for said five thousand shares of said
Capital Stock of said The Capital Mountain Tunnel & Milling
Company properly endorsed by the said party of the first
part, which said certificates of stock so deposited are to

be delivered by said The Denver National Bank of Denver, free and clear from all liens, claims or incumbrances of any kind or nature whatsoever, to said parties of the second part, upon the payment by said parties of the second part to said party of the first part, of said sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars, together with interest at the rate of six per cent per annum from said 10th day of March, A. D. 1892, on or before the said 20th day of December, A. D. 1893, or the deposit of said sum and interest to the credit of said party of the first part, with said The Denver National Bank, of Denver.
