SILVER WING PROPERTY

Located about one mile and a half above Eureka, San Juan County, Colorado.

The Silver Wing vein, shown on accompanying map, is about 8 feet wide where opened in a 1700-foot cross-cut tunnel. It is a complex sulphide carrying from 7 to 10% combined lead, zinc, and copper with 5 to 20 oz. silver and about 1/10 oz. gold per ton.

The Frederica vein also belongs to this property. It is opened by several adits near the top of the mountain over 11,000 feet in elevation. It is principally galena and chalcopyrite carrying 50 to 75 oz. silver.
