The Reuleaux Writing Grant (RWG) is a selective grant intended to recognize and encourage undergraduate research scholars to publish their findings in Reuleaux. Students who are selected to receive the grant are expected to work closely with their mentor, the Writing Center, and the Reuleaux editing team to create a polished manuscript for Reuleaux known as a Reuleaux Writing Grant Publication (RWGP).
