Ore is an oxide.

Ore deposit is a fissure vein from 6" to 4' in width as shown on the surface and underground.

67 foot shaft- 30 feet below the collar of the shaft is a drift 90 feet south and 24 feet north-east.
- 60 feet down from the collar is a drift 72 feet south-west and 20 feet north-east.
