. MR BAKER DID NOT LEAVE THE MAP HERE. I MARKED OUT A BOUT THE WAY THE CLAIMS LAY THAT WE TAKEN UP . YOU CAN LAY THE MAP AT THE S.W. CORNER OF THE UPPER PATENTED CLAIM . OF THE FLEECE GROUP, THEN YOU CAN FIND HOW THEY LAY. I MADE A LITTLE MAP A BOUT THE WAY THE GENERAL SHERMAN , LITTLE GEM ,ORE HOUSE. AND THE 4 MILE, AND ONE MILE, TUNNELSITE LAY. AND THE THREE IRON LOBES. I FIND THE GENERAL SHERMAN LOWER TUNNEL IS 26 FEET LOWER THEN THE MOUTH OF THE GOLDEN FLEECE BIG TUNNEL , .

.THE LOWER GENERAL SHERMAN TUNNEL IS IN 1000 FEET AND RUN A CROSS THE 60 FOOT VEIN THAT IS RUNNING A BOUT EAST, AND WEST. THE TUNNEL THAT CUT A CROSS THE BIG 60 FOOT VEIN SOUTH OF THE GLADIATOR, CLAIM, IS 275 FEET A BOVE THE LOWER TUNNEL THE NORTH WALL OR NORTH SIDE OF THIS VEIN IS WHAT RUN \$12.40 IN GOLD. 20 FEET WIDE FROM THE SOUTH WALL RUN \$1.60 IN GOLD.

I FINE THAT THE ORE ON THE BUMP OF THE LOWER TUNNEL BELONGS TO THE GLADIATOR. AND THE BUMP EAST OF MY MILL, IS EAST OF THE GENERAL SHERMAN SIDE LINE.

THE TUNNEL ON THE LITTLE GEM IS IN OVER 200 FEET AND IS 500 FEET A BOVE THE LOWER GENERAL SHERMAN TUNNEL.

THERE IS 2 VEINS SHOWING IN THIS LITTLE GEM TUNNEL, ONE OF THEM RUN \$3.60 IN GOLD.

THE BIG VEIN IS CAPED OVER THROUGH THE TUNNEL SITES, THEN IT SHOWS UP ON THE SURFACE IN THE IRON LOADS.
