THE LOYAL GROUP

The Loyal Group of lode and vein mining claims comprise four claims, to-wit: the Loyal: Legacy: Lily and Lilac: situate lying and being on Mount Good Hope in the Columbia Mining District, Pitkin County, Colorado. Developments consists of about seven hundred feet of tunneling, crosscuts and drifts. A four foot streak of solid Iron sulphide, (Pyrites) is penetrated by a crosscut that averages 50% sulphur, 45% Iron per ton. The U. S. Geologic survey designate the ore a first class commercial product.

The property is on the blue lime contact about twelve miles from Aspen Colorado, the nearest R.R. point. Owing to the distance to the Railroad and the low price per ton paid for sulphide ore's it is doubtful if we ever get a market for the product.

The mines of note on the contact between the Loyal group and Aspen are, the Midnight: The Hope: The Little Annie: The Puzzler's and the A. Y. Renolds group. of lode mining claims.

The Loyal group of claims are unpatented and held by possessory title.
