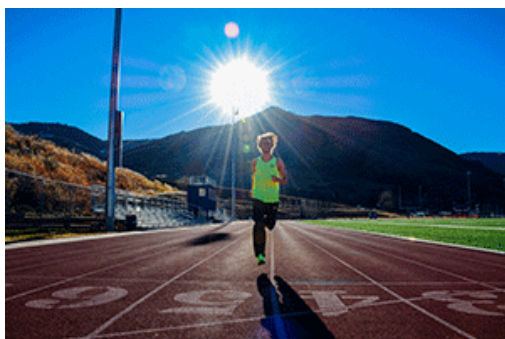

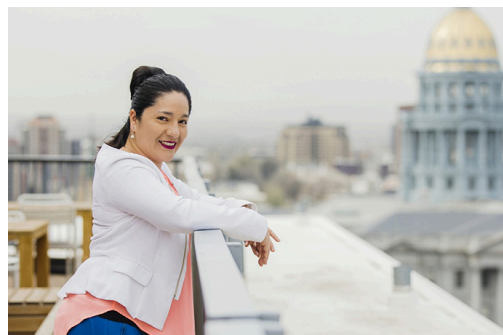
Mines Athletics Receives \$6.5 Million Gift
