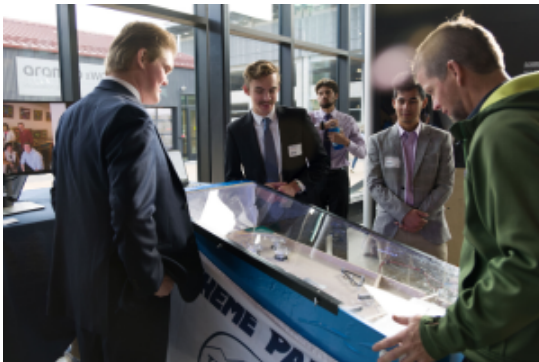

Mines team awarded \$2.5M to measure cosmic rays from the stratosphere via balloon

Mines physics assistant professor Eric Mayotte is a lead on the interdisciplinary, consortium grant awarded by NASA to 10 international institutions. Mines' part involves launching a super-pressure balloon carrying 3,000 pounds of equipment to measure information more than 18 miles above Earth.
